

Wefaq seeks details of action plan

Al Wefaq bloc has asked the government to provide full details of the national action plan within 10 days so that they can discuss it in Parliament.

This was revealed in a statement released by the bloc that states that they have expressed concern over the national plan that was announced by the Prime Minister, Shaikh Khalifa bin Salman Al Khalifa.

According to the statement, there is no analysis available and the plan may not be effective in the next four years.

The bloc is demanding details like the allocation of the budget, the date of commencing of the project...etc. The members are insisting that the authorities should introduce detailed action plan within 10 days so that they have time to assess the plan and discuss it in the Chamber of Deputies.

Seventeen members of the bloc took oath on Wednesday after boycotting the inaugural and procedural sessions. Three members of the bloc – Khalil Marzooq, Shaikh Hassan Sultan and Jalal Fairouz – walked out in protest as they were disappointed with some of the newly appointed Shura Council members and ministers in the Cabinet.
