THE ARAB DEMOCRACY INDEX



This first annual report on the state of democracy in the Arab world is based on data gathered within the Arab Democracy Index covering three key dimensions: the constitutional and legal angle; public opinion and impressions; and the actual behaviour patterns of regimes in power, based on their performance on the ground, and documented reports regarding the way central authorities exercise their power. Measurement is based, therefore, on monitoring performance and behaviour rather than just examining intentions and theoretical criteria, like legislation and rules.

This report is edited by the Palestinian Centre for Policy and Survey Research and coordinated by the Arab Reform Initiative. It is the result of a close collaboration between ten different institutions selected by ARI, some of which are members of the Initiative. The report reflects one of the main objectives of ARI, namely to nurture Arab research capacity and promote a home-grown vision of reform and of the priorities as defined from the region.
