

Mohammed briefed on plans to improve educational system

His Highness Shaikh Mohammed bin Rashid Al Maktoum, Vice-President and Prime Minister of the UAE and Ruler of Dubai, and General Shaikh Mohammed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Abu Dhabi Crown Prince and Deputy Supreme Commander of the UAE Armed Forces, were briefed yesterday by Education Minister Dr Hanif Hassan at the Presidential Palace in Abu Dhabi on the features and components of the proposed educational strategy aimed at developing the educational system in the country.
